Basis for the Project

- External training of involved institutions and organisations

Temporary River Basin Authority

- 2-3 persons in Kaliningrad and 2-3 persons in Poland
- Responsible for production of the river basin management plan
- Responsible for project arrangements (training, seminars...)
- Cooperation with existing authorities and institutions in Kaliningrad and Poland
- Support from Swedish experts

The temporary Authority will:

- Produce a River Basin Management
 Plan according to EU Water Framework
 Directive
- Communicate the project with the sectors, authorities and other stakeholders concerned within the Lyna/Lava River basin
- Train and develop the skills of the Authority staff and key actors in Water Management
